	Collier Springs	<p>34°29'01" N 93°35'33" W</p> <p>34°28'46" N 93°35'35" W</p>	<p>Parking / Picnic area. Trail starts behind the outhouse. Follow the ridge to the top, look for evidence of trails / digs.</p> <p>Small turnout. Park and cross the berm. Follow the trail. Cross the river twice. Look for washouts uphill in the narrows before crossing a third time.</p>
Utah	Rock Corral	38°22'12" N 112°50'01" W	Caves, washouts and trails start above the fence line. Smoky quartz.
Wisconsin	McCaslin Mtn.	<p>45°22'29" N 88°37'43" W</p> <p>45°22'22" N 88°37'22" W</p>	<p>Quartz Hill Trailhead Parking. Cross Hwy 32 to the trail.</p> <p>Western Extension of McCaslin. Loose in soil and holes. "NO DIGGING" only surface collection. Precambrian Crystal.</p>
	Necedah Bluff	<p>44°01'13" N 90°04'43" W</p> <p>44°01'18" N 90°04'37" W</p>	<p>Parking at end of road. Former quarry. Precambrian Crystal.</p> <p>Large piles of quartzite with crystals in veins. Quarry is on the south west side of the hill.</p>
